More Issues for Your Comments

As promised in our [last message](#), we now have an expanded list of issues you can include in your comments to the Hearing Examiner about the proposed project at Point Wells. We are hoping to get a sizable number of residents to comment in person on May 17th and 18th, but if you can't make it up to Everett we ask you to consider submitting your comments via email using the instructions at the end of this newsletter.

We know many of you have already submitted email comments; that's great and we thank you. If you have sent in a comment already, you can always send in another as there's no limit on how many you can submit.

For those who want to comment in person, the hearing and public comments will take place at the Snohomish County campus in the Robert J. Drewel Building (Admin-East Bldg) in Room 2 on the 1st floor (Stillaguamish Room), located at 3000 Rockefeller Avenue in Everett. There will be two opportunities for you to comment.

- Thursday, May 17th starting at 1:30 pm and extending until at least 7 pm. The County has committed to keeping the hearing open beyond 7 pm to allow anyone arriving before 7 pm to offer their comments.
- Friday, May 18th starting at 9 am. The County has not committed to a specific length of time for this period so it is advising the public to arrive at 9 am if they want to be assured of an opportunity to speak.

What are the new issues?

We've identified 9 issues that we believe are important to comment on and are easy to understand. You can see the full list on our [Issues page](#) on the [Sno-King Coalition](#) web site.

For each of the 9 issues we've included some bullet points that provide more detail about missing or incorrect information in the application.

We suggest you pick just one or two of the issues for your comment. You don't need to include all the bullet points, just a couple of them, and then use the final bullet point (no more extensions, reject the application) as your conclusion. ***It's even better if you can make your comment using your own words and if possible, add how the issue affects you personally.***

Can't come? Send your comments by email!

The Hearing Examiner has promised to read every comment received before the end of the hearing. If you can't make it to the hearing in person, email your comments to hearing.examiner@snoco.org. It would help to put "Comment for Point Wells Hearing" in the subject line.

The County has done its part by recommending denial of the application. It's time for us to do our part by supporting that recommendation with our comments.
