County Council sets October 3 Hearing date for Pt. Wells Appeal

In our last newsletter we told you that the Hearing Examiner had re-affirmed his denial of BSRE's development application for Pt. Wells, and that BSRE had appealed the denial to the County Council. At the time of that newsletter the Council had not yet set a hearing date. That date has now been set.

The hearing will take place on Wednesday, October 3, 2018 at 1:30 pm in the Council Chambers on the 8th floor of the Robert J. Drewel Building, 3000 Rockefeller Ave. in Everett.

BSRE will have 20 minutes to present their arguments, then the public will have three minutes each to make their comments. This is our last chance to have our opinion heard as the next level of appeal will be to Superior Court where only BSRE and the County can present arguments.

We've got an army of residents to speak for you

We think it is important that our neighborhood be heard before the Council makes its decision. We also know it can be difficult for many people to make time during a weekday to attend a hearing, so we've got you covered. We organized a small army of local residents who will be at the hearing to offer comments. RB resident Tom McCormick has written about a dozen short papers each covering one issue under appeal, and members of our army will be there to read each of the issue papers to the Council.

We think the most likely outcome is that the Council will re-affirm the Hearing Examiner's decision, but that's not a guarantee. We will of course let you know when the Council decision is announced.
