Hearing Delayed Until May 10, 2019

BSRE submitted a last minute request to delay their appeal hearing originally scheduled for April 19th. The stated reason was that they were in the process of hiring a project manager and they believed it was essential that the project manager attend the hearing.

The City of Shoreline and Snohomish County both objected to the delay, pointing out that BSRE hasn't had a project manager for the entire 8 years since the project was submitted in 2011 so it's not clear why having one now is "essential". They also argued that this is a closed record hearing where no testimony is allowed and a new project manager who knew nothing about the project's history would be unable to offer any advice to BSRE's attorneys, so at best the new project manager would be an interested spectator.

Nevertheless, Judge McHale granted the request for delay and set the new hearing date as May 10, 2019 at 1:30, still in the King County Courthouse.
